Money Smart Student Ambassador Program

BFCC's unique and one of a kind program that has been tested and proven very positive results since 2012: **Money Smart Student Ambassador Program** where we provide Train the Trainer classes to High School students utilizing the online FDIC Money Smart Modules. The students work in teams with their mentor/teacher and create a presentation for their peers. It is the basic concept of students teaching students thru their creations. Their creations in the form of presentations, videos or games are then judged and compete for monetary prizes. **A program designed in educating students before graduating high school in order for them to make better financial decisions for themselves and that of their families.**

The pandemic turned everything upside down and our in person summits were canceled since 2019. BFCC continued its programs and in 2020 4 high schools participated and in 2021 it increased to 10 high schools participation. We are very proud of the students and their presentations and you can view the results by going to our bfccrgv.com website to see the presentations they created.

BFCC is very proud to report that for our 2022 summit we anticipate more high schools participating since 10 have already gone thru the Train the Trainer Class and other high schools are joining in anticipating approximately 14 high schools participating in the April 2022 Summit. Due to the ongoing risks that the pandemic has brought our region, we will continue to record the presentations and judge them at that time also. Our Target is to continue to have our summits in April of 2022 to celebrate Financial Education National Month. We anticipated reaching out to many more students than in the past because we learned that with technology we can reach thousands and not just what would fit in an auditorium. We want to be able to reach the total student population at each high school by taking the presentations to their websites and their TV stations. BFCC would like to live stream this event if possible and be able to share it with all high school students of all grade levels. We believe that with the help of technology, students will have the opportunity to observe and learn from our Money Smart Student Ambassadors who represent their schools.

Labor of Love Student Financial Program

BFCC will conduct Train the Trainer classes specifically designed for at risk students in High School (mainly attending Lincoln Park High School in Brownsville) that have recently become mothers or will soon be mothers and are striving to get their high school diploma thru this difficult time. BFCC conducts these classes via zoom or face to face whatever is possible and provides assistance in getting them thru the FDIC Money Smart modules. After a 4 month training, the student is invited to a Financial Education Workshop which includes, Dress for

Success sessions, interview sessions as well as an invitation to a special luncheon with community leader speakers to share their stories with the students. It is an opportunity for sponsors to help our most at risk students reach their potential and help them meet their goals and that of their families.

Save for College Student/Household Program

BFCC has designed 5 hr training including a Bilingual Financial Educations Training Series for Parents. This training is basically targeting the student/parent and encourages them to work together to plan for the student future.

We are very pleased to report that with this training we are reaching out the elementary level, starting them on the financial education road needed to succeed. We are planting the seed of learning how to do short term saving/long term saving and setting financial goals for what they would like their future to look like. Parents are also taught to Get Smart about their credit and to Learn how to set goals and SAVE, SAVE, SAVE. utilizing the FDIC Money Smart Modules. The ultimate goal is to set up that savings account at a local bank to encourage both parent/student to continue their savings program for their future.

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BFCC continues to assist financial institutions with their CRA outreach. BFCC is reaching out to our low to moderate students/parents in our community and know that if you are a financial institution you can get CRA Credit for the contribution to our organization . Keep in mind that your giving will determine the number of hours/students you will be receiving while judging, teaching, or interacting with the students.
